## **This funding will be used to**

- Improve student level of achievement outcomes in English by systematic, explicit teaching of reading and writing in the curriculum.
- Improve to 90% of students receiving a C or better in English.
- Improve to 50% A and B in English.

## **Our initiatives include**

- All staff to be engaged in using the Greenvale State School Inquiry cycle process to determine curriculum, student learning plans, next steps and strategies using data from Literacy Continuum, Early Start and Curriculum assessment.
- Develop and trial school protocols for coaching, observations and feedback for teachers and teacher aides around reading and writing in the curriculum.

## **Our school will improve student outcomes by**

- Employing additional staff to embed a Greenvale State School Inquiry Cycle process adapting a co-teaching approach, for every student.
- The expected cost will be \$19,505.
